PHASE 2:

APPLICATION PERIOD

Application will close and review of all applicants will commence.



PHASE 3:

INTERVIEWS & SELECTION

After an interview process, a Lone Finalist will be named with a start date of August 9.

July 11-15

Board will conduct first-round interviews.

July 18

Board will conduct second-round interviews.

July 18

The Lone Finalist will be named and announced.

August 9

Tentative first day of employment for the next Superintendent.
