Mr. David Pate welcomed committee members and presented a recap of the August meeting which included the general fund multi-year forecast and listed current and forecasted student enrollment.

Mr. David Pate explained the general fund's 2023-2024 budget by providing a function category summary of payroll and non-payroll costs. Staffing full time equivalent yearly numbers were reviewed.

Mr. David Pate provided an overview of projected student enrollment. Transfers in and out of the district were noted and a survey delivered explanations of why families left Richardson Independent School District. Handouts included: Year-to-Year Weekly Enrollment Chart and the Texas Education Agency Student Transfer Report for 2022-2023.

Information on campus capacity verses enrollment in the 2022-2023 school year was discussed. The Enrollment and Capacity Report of Elementary Schools on the snapshot date, October 28, 2022 was provided to committee members.
