

The District Planning Committee met on Thursday, September 14, 2023 at 8:30 am at the Arzell Ball Center, 410 South Greenville Avenue, Richardson, Texas.

The District Planning Committee is made up of community members, parents, and staff who assist the District by reviewing the District Improvement Plan and our priority goals as determined by the Board of Trustees, and our District of Innovation Plan as needed.

Chief of Staff Mike Jasso welcomed members and reviewed the agenda for the day.

Committee norms and purpose were noted and the group engaged in a team building activity, providing feedback regarding the beginning of the year celebrations and improvements.

Mr. Jasso presented background information regarding the development of the District Improvement Plan and reviewed the Strategic Plan goals. The District Improvement Plan components were noted and the District Improvement Plan and the Campus Improvement Plan timelines were reviewed.

Committee members worked in groups to provide feedback on each goal. Each group reported goal reviews, expectations, and questions.

David Pate presented an overview report of the Community Budget Steering Committee, such as the meeting schedule, purpose, and last year's committee recommendations to address budget challenges. Mr. Pate noted that this year's Community Budget Steering Committee will continue developing recommendations for next steps.

Joe Miniscalco provided information regarding the district's learning environment refresh, explaining the Code of Civility expectations focused on safety, respect, and responsibility and student cell phone policy. Morgan Cave explained the district's Student and Teacher Growth Goals focus and implementation.

Mike Jasso reviewed the district's Parent & Family Engagement Policy.
