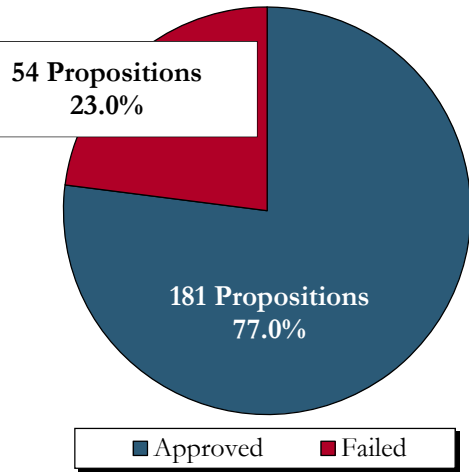
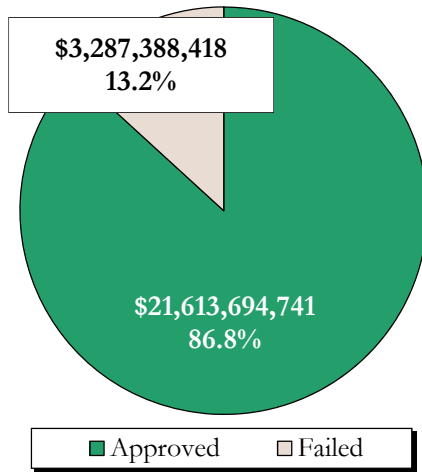

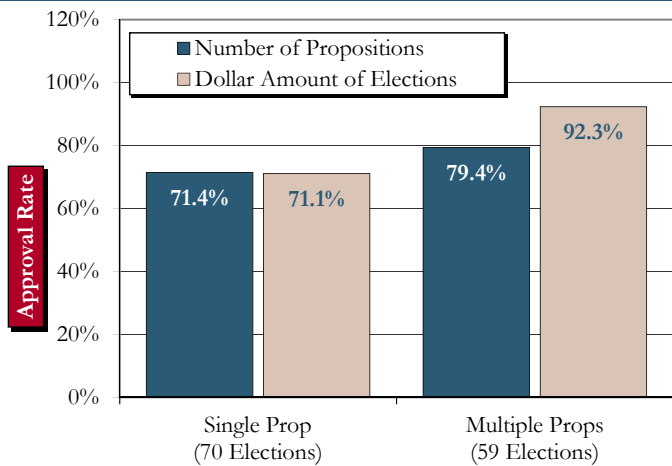
Unofficial Results by Number of Propositions



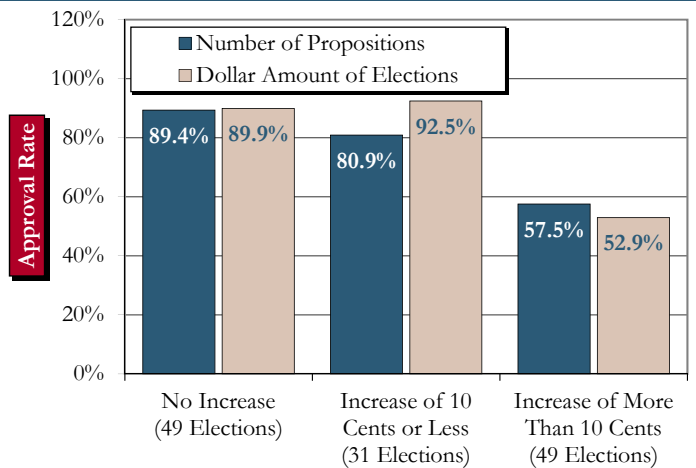
Unofficial Results by Dollar Amount of Elections



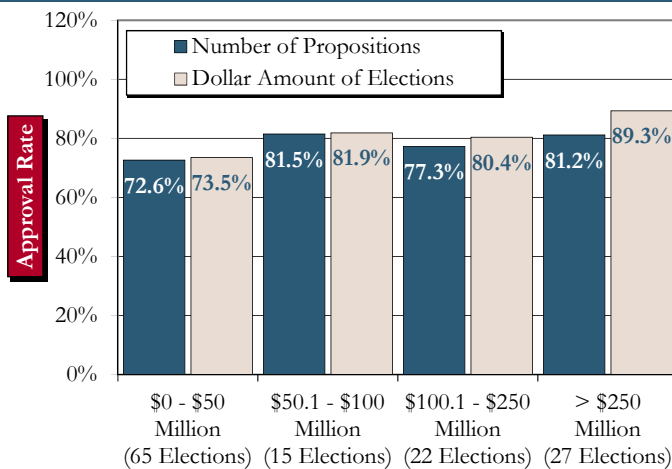
Single Proposition vs. Multiple Proposition



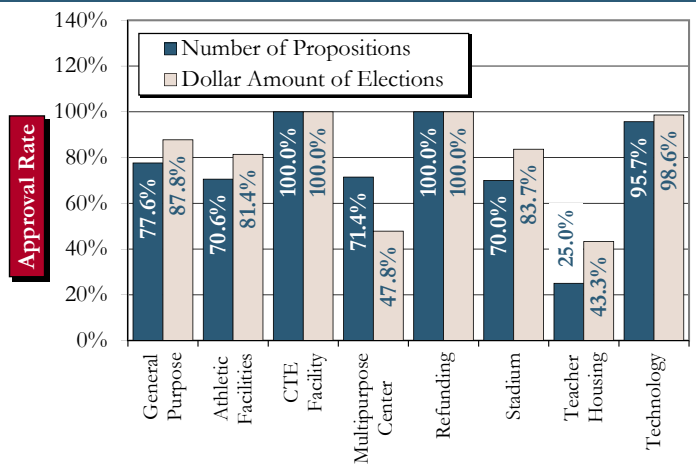
Interest and Sinking Fund Tax Rate Increase

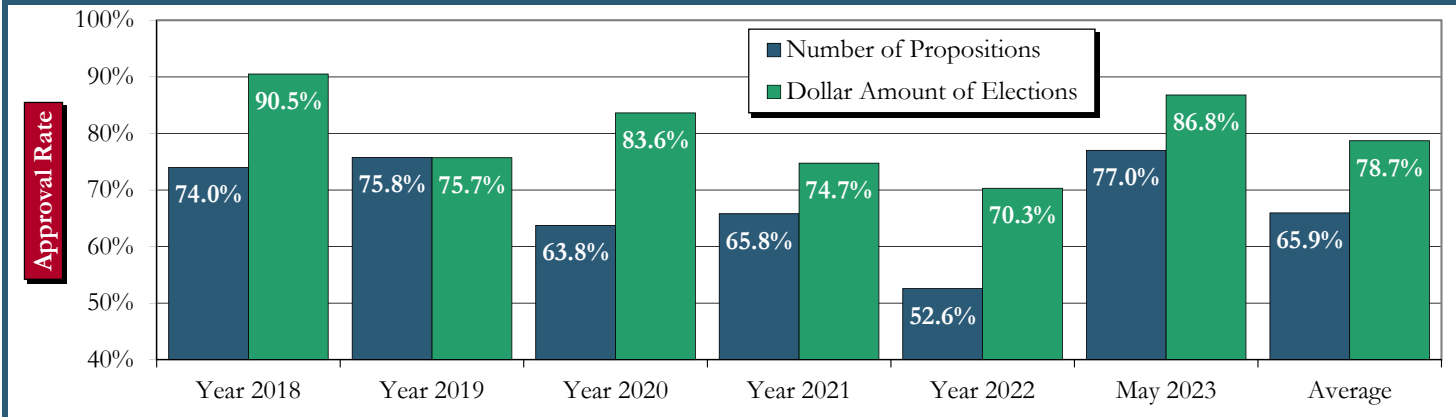

As shown below, approximately 86.8% of the proposed \$24.9 billion of Texas public school district bonds were approved by voters in May 2023 and 77.0% of all propositions were approved by voters. The average historical approval rate since year 2018 is 78.7% by dollar amount and 65.9% by number of propositions.
