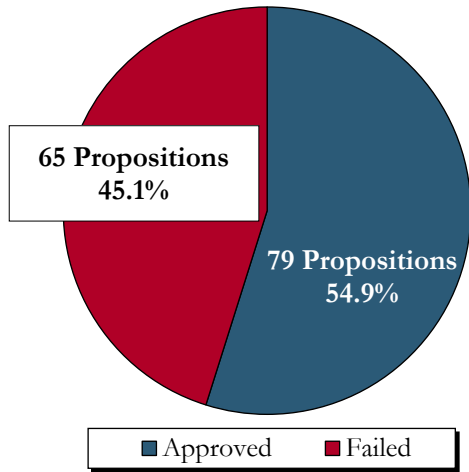
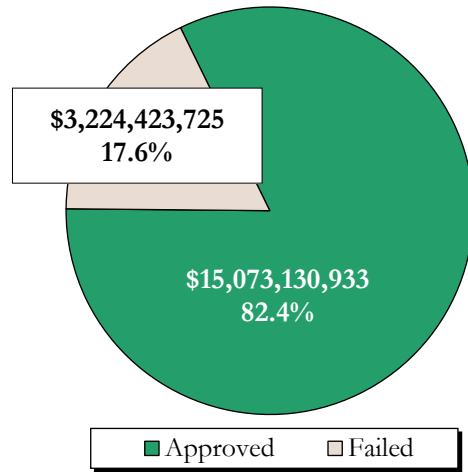

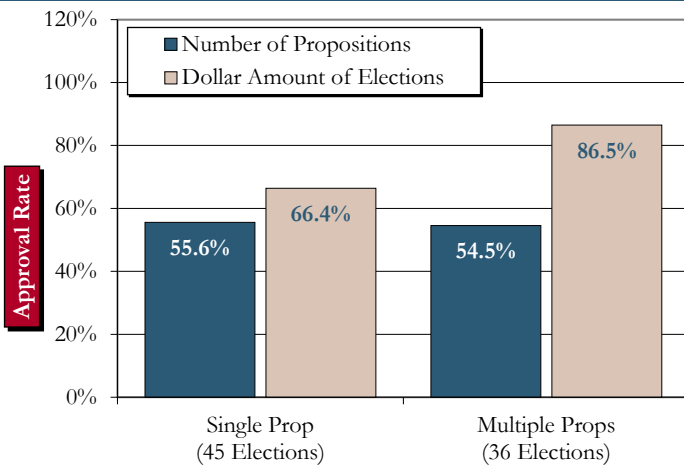
Unofficial Results by Number of Propositions



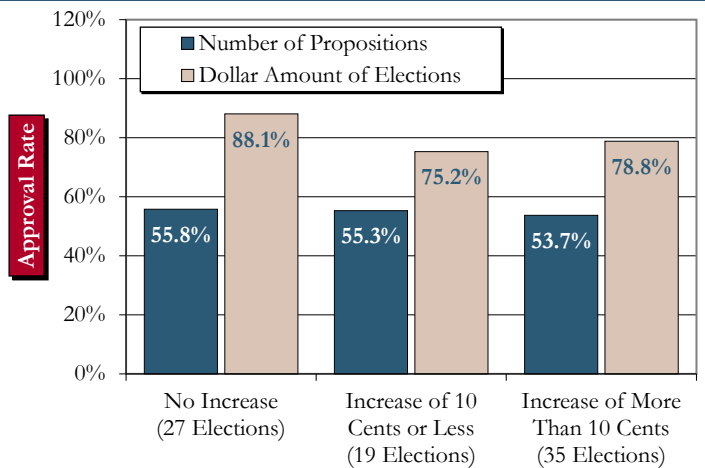
Unofficial Results by Dollar Amount of Elections



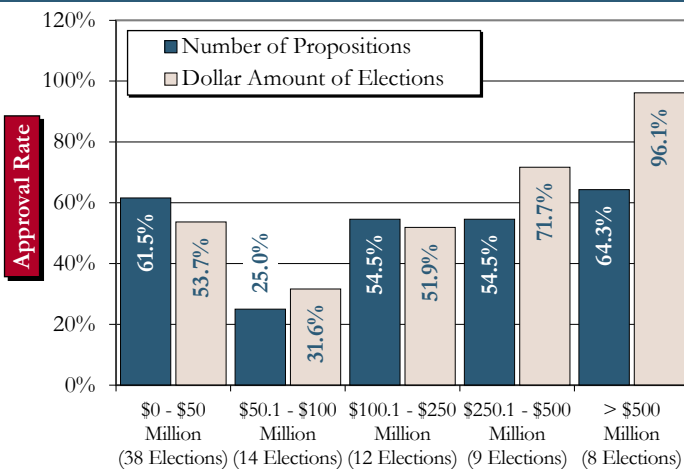
Single Proposition Vs. Multiple Proposition



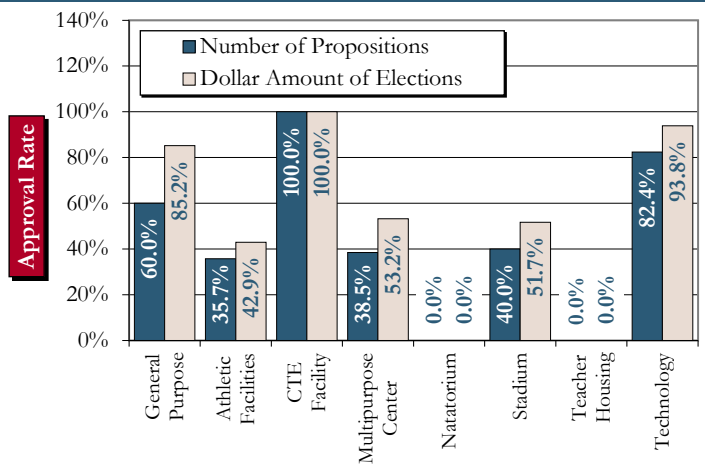
Interest and Sinking Fund Tax Rate Increase

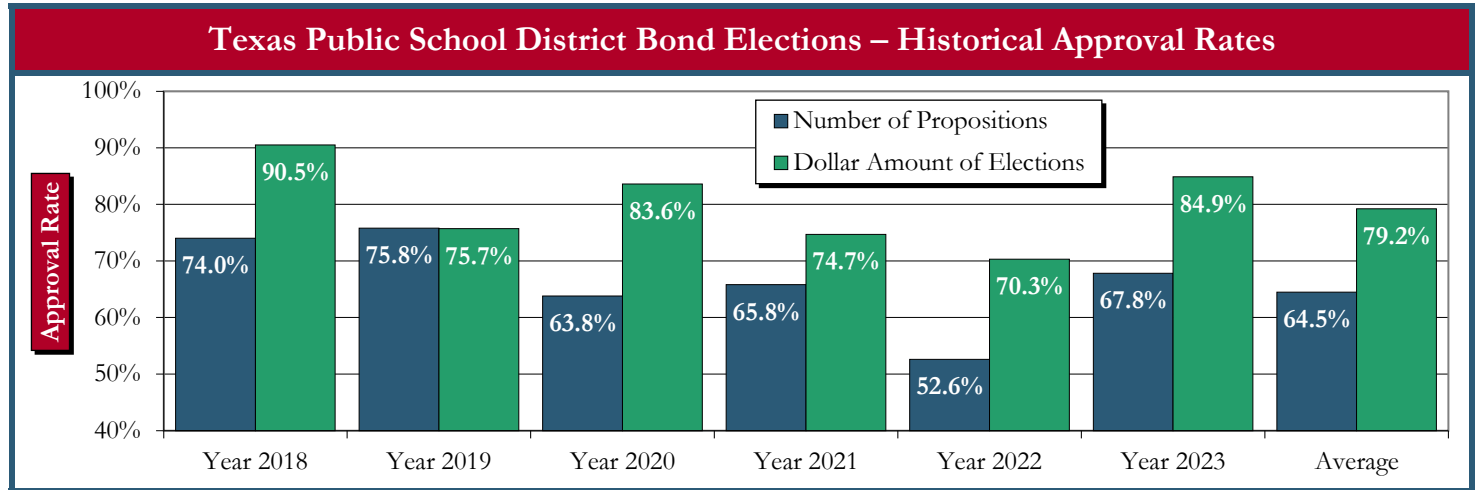

# Texas Public School Districts – Bond Election Results for November 7, 2023



As shown below, approximately 84.9% of the proposed \$43.2 billion of Texas public school district bonds were approved by voters in year 2023 and 67.8% of all propositions were approved by voters. The average historical approval rate since year 2018 is 79.2% by dollar amount and 64.5% by number of propositions.
