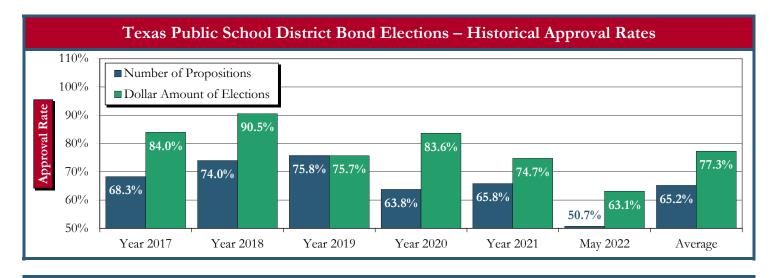

As shown below, approximately 63.1% of the proposed \$16.56 billion of Texas public school district bonds were approved by voters in May 2022 and 50.7% of all propositions were approved by voters. The average historical approval rate since year 2017 is 77.3% by dollar amount and 65.2% by number of propositions.
