On November 4, 2025, the RISD community will vote on the district's \$1.4 billion bond.

The three propositions include funds designed to address projects across the district as prioritized by the Bond Steering Committee.



PROPOSITION A

Construction and Instructional Materials

Includes proposed construction of six middle schools, a CTE Center, and an Environmental Center.

\$1,338,600,000



PROPOSITION B

Technology Devices

Includes planned replacement of devices for students, staff, CTE labs, and library and media centers.

\$54,000,000



PROPOSITION C

Stadium Upgrades

Includes ADA upgrades, lighting, and turf replacement at RISD's two largest stadiums.

\$7,400,000

How will the Bond Affect Taxes?

If passed, the bond is estimated to increase the I&S (Interest & Sinking) tax rate by \$0.04. For RISD homeowners under age 65 with a home of an average market value of \$500,000, this results in an estimated annual increase of \$124, or \$10 per month.

No Tax Increase for 65 or Older

Homeowners 65 or older are not impacted by a tax increase because they qualify to have their property tax levy frozen when they turn 65.

The frozen tax levy does not stay in place if a homeowner makes a substantial improvement to their home.

PLANNED PROJECTS IN PROPOSITION A

Construction & Instructional Materials

\$1,338,600,000

Proposition A is a general bond proposition which allows a district to list all areas not required by law to be separate. All district departments are covered in this proposition, making it the largest proposition.

Infrastructure and Safety

- Roofing and HVAC
- Safety and security upgrades
- · Health services upgrades
- School buses and maintenance vehicles
- Equipment for schools, classrooms, cafeterias, offices, and maintenance

Construction and Renovation

- Six middle schools: Apollo, Liberty, North, Parkhill, West, and Westwood

- Environmental Center

Teaching and Student Support

- Instructional and curriculum materials
- CTE equipment
- Fine Arts instruments, uniforms, and instructional materials
- Athletic uniforms, equipment, and turf replacements
