NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION RESULTS
November 4, 2025

The voters of the Richardson Independent School District approved the following propositions in the special election held on November 4, 2025 (the “Proposition”).

RICHARDSON ISD – PROPOSITION A

THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

Shall the board of trustees of Richardson Independent School District be authorized to issue and sell bonds of the District in the principal amount of \$1,338,600,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, improving and equipping school buildings of the District, for the purchase of necessary sites for school buildings, for the purchase of new school buses, for the retrofitting of school buses with emergency, safety, or security equipment, and for the purchase or retrofitting of vehicles to be used for emergency, safety, or security purposes; and shall there be levied, assessed and collected annually ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the District sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same become due and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed or authorized in anticipation of, in relation to or in connection with the bonds; said bonds to be issued in one or more series or issues, to mature serially or otherwise not more than 40 years from their date, and to bear interest at such rate or rates not to exceed the limit prescribed by law at the time of issuance, as the board of trustees in its discretion shall determine?

RICHARDSON ISD – PROPOSITION B

THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

Shall the board of trustees of Richardson Independent School District be authorized to issue and sell bonds of the District in the principal amount of \$54,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring, improving and equipping technology and technology infrastructure, including computers and tablets and other technology devices for the

District; and shall there be levied, assessed and collected annually ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the District sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same become due and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed or authorized in anticipation of, in relation to or in connection with the bonds; said bonds to be issued in one or more series or issues, to mature serially or otherwise not more than 40 years from their date, and to bear interest at such rate or rates not to exceed the limit prescribed by law at the time of issuance, as the board of trustees in its discretion shall determine?

RICHARDSON ISD – PROPOSITION C

THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

Shall the board of trustees of Richardson Independent School District be authorized to issue and sell bonds of the District in the principal amount of \$7,400,000 for the purpose of acquiring, improving and equipping District football stadium facilities, including LED lighting, turf replacement and improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act; and shall there be levied, assessed and collected annually ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the District sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same become due and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed or authorized in anticipation of, in relation to or in connection with the bonds; said bonds to be issued in one or more series or issues, to mature serially or otherwise not more than 40 years from their date, and to bear interest at such rate or rates not to exceed the limit prescribed by law at the time of issuance, as the board of trustees in its discretion shall determine?
